Thursday 3.20pm-4.20pm - Year 6 SATs Club with Mrs Plummer starting 12.09.23


Miss Hellawell will be running lunchtime clubs for Collective Worship group and a Reading for Pleasure group. The children will be signing up over the next few weeks.
