Maths



First, we will finish our unit on addition and subtraction within 20. We will then progress onto looking at numbers to 50. We will explore finding one more and one less using our existing knowledge and a 100 square. We will learn how to identify the tens and ones in two digit numbers up to 50 and explore basic addition/ subtraction of tens and ones too. We will use greater than , and less than < to compare numbers. We will think about using our stem sentences and reasoning skills to explain how we know, prove our answer and think about how we can master concepts. We will look carefully at the patterns that we notice and apply the knowledge we have learnt to a range pf problems including word problems.



In RE we will be focusing on the Christian celebration of Easter. We will think about the importance of the build up to Easter over lent, why Easter is special to Christians and what they remember at this time. We will also be thinking about new life and how this relates to Easter and spring time.

In computing we are going to continue coding and programming. We will think about how to input instructions and follow code. We will also use the internet safely to research and find out lots of facts about England's capital city!

In music this half term we will learn the United Kingdom's national anthem and London's Burning nursery rhyme. We will think about what these two iconic songs/anthems symbolise and why they are important.

GeographyHistory

In geography we will be looking at the human and natural geological features around us and London. We will learn the placement of the united kingdom and label key capital cities. We will use Google Earth to explore features of the city and use key vocabulary such as 'settlement' and 'tourism.' We will also learn directions - North/South/East/West. In history we will be learning about 'The Great Fire of London, when and why did it happen? Could anything of stopped it?

English



Writing: This half term we will be reading 'The Queen's Knickers' 'Naughty Bus' and lots of different fact books all about our capital city. We will focus on using talk for writing to share ideas, extract key vocabulary, create shared writes, story maps and retell through drama and role play. By using a special story layout, opening/build up/dilemma/ resolution/ending we will focus on the overall structure. We will think carefully about our handwriting keeping our letters neat, an even size and on the line. We will continue to learn how to use pre-cursive focusing on the lead ins and flicks and think about ascenders and descenders.

Grammar: We will be focusing on what a noun is and how to use a noun in a noun phrase. Again, we will be recapping when to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in the correct places. Can I re-read my writing and does it make sense? We will continue to learn about commas, question marks and exclamation marks and when they are used.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be focusing on how to keep safe. How can we keep ourselves and others safe. We will also think about managing risk. Why some risk can be good but how we can be safe and manage the risks we take.
