
I think this year so many of us have put up our Christmas decorations already to ensure we make the most of the festive time and I know the children are getting very excited!



The children are more than welcome to put on their Christmas jumpers for the day!




We have begun to prepare for our Christmas nativities in school and the children are certainly enjoying getting into character and have begun to learn their lines.
