Muck, Mess and Mixtures

We will be continuing to get messy and explore this exciting and fabulously fun topic.

GEOGRAPHY - We will explore different foods and the countries they come from.

SCIENCE – We will be investigating how different mixtures react when melted and mixed. We will also be making banana bread and flapjacks.

DESIGN- We will be following recipes and cooking, melting, sorting and tasting different foods.

COMPUTING - We will be word processing, writing up our recipes for our class recipe book..

FOREST SCHOOL - We will be having Forest School sessions every Thursday afternoon. Please make sure children have long sleeved tops, long trousers and a waterproof in school.

MUSIC - We will be explore singing games, creating some, looking at tempo & dynamics and the simple notation of rhythmic patterns.
