In Literacy:

We shall be writing character descriptions, narratives, newspaper reports and information leaflets. Our class story will be Tom's Midnight Garden.

In Science:

Our science will be linked to our P.S.H.E. we will compare key facts about mammalian gestation and birth and suggest reasons for variation between species. We will also be taking part in the 3M Young Innovators challenge.

In Music:

We will be looking at music through history and using ideas of each period to create our own piece of music, starting with baroque, classical, romantic, and finishing with modern music.

In Maths:

Our focus this term will be on reasoning and problem solving with a focus on time and measurement. We will continue to practise the four rules of number on a daily basis .

In Geography:

We will investigate how life and our local area have changed over time. We will talk to local residents for first hand evidence.

In History:

We will be looking at changes over the last century and extending our chronological knowledge.

In RE:

Our focus will be on the new Testament, from the birth of Jesus through to Revelation.

In computing we will:

use software to change digital images of ourselves, experimenting with sepia tones to age the image and use them to make digital montages in the style of Andy Warhol.

In Art & Design:

Our focus will be on the artist Salvador Dali and the use of clock imagery in his art work. We will also be making observational drawings.

In PHSE:

We shall look at how our bodies change as we approach puberty and look at conception and pregnancy as part of our sex education programme. We will also look at setting personal targets and feeling positive.
