Initially in maths we will be looking at i within 10. Sorting guantities to 10. using addition,

Counting back from 10, and focusing on the number patterns. We will also be learning how to read and write numbers to 10, focusing on one more and one less ring quantities within 10, looking at or eal numbers and number

lines.We will also be using part, part, whole models within 10 focusing on the structure of 10 as a whole and looking at the numbers which added together equate to 10. The children will focus on recalling number bonds and begin to make associations within addition and subtraction. We will use a range of practical manipulatives to explore numbers/quantities within 10.

Will you read me a story?

Year 1

This half term we will be learning all about traditional tales and storytelling. We will delve into different childhood stories and bring them to life across the curriculum!

In Christianity we will be learning about story of creation - who made the world, what do christians believe? What do I feel? How is the creation story relevant to me? We will be thinking what does it mean to be part of a faith community? What links do we have we Long Whatton Church?

In computing with Miss EllaWe will be learning how to use chrome books, how to login, use simpl programs. We will continue to look at how to be

safe using the internet and online programs.

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In music this half term we are going to use a variety of different instruments to explore rhythm and pitch. We will explore composing different pieces of music and making soundscapes in groups. We will explore moving to the beat and joining in with Harvest songs and traditional ydances

Science

be testing different materials to build houses to help the three little pigs. We will sort materials according to their properties, test their strength and durability. We will be exploring shape, weight, forces and the effect of gravity building bridges.

During harvest we will be looking at healthy eating, comparing and contrasting the different food groups and the importance and role of fruits and vegetables in our diets. We will be growing beans from seed, caring for and nurturing the seed to grow. Using the poly tunnel we will learn about the different kinds of vegetable and fruit plants and compare their structures/properties

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In geography we will look at our surrounding area and learn basic geological vocabulary to describe our surroundings. We will begin to think about seasonal changes and talk about what we notice.

We will revise phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs focusing on recognising and blending these taught graphemes within words. As the term progresses we will begin to learn alternative graphemes and representations. Writing: This half term we will be reading and writing all about different traditional tales - 'Goldilocks and The Three Bears,' 'Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs,' 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff,' 'The Gingerbread Man, 'Jack and the Beanstalk.'We will focus on using talk for writing, retelling through drama and role play. We will focus on using our magic 5, use storytelling language and conjunctions. We will think carefully about our handwriting keeping our letters neat, an even size and on the line. Grammar: We will be focusing on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in the correct places. Can I re-read my writing and does it make sense?

PSHE

In PSHE with Mrs York this half term the children will focus on theirselves and their relationships within class. We will focus on how to feel safe, happy and secure in school. What they can do to get to know others in their class, how can I welcome someone new? We we review how we feel in new situations and reflect on what can help us. The children will think deeply about what they are good at and what is special about themselves. They will think carefully about recognising and sharing emotions, thinking about how to manage feelings ad how best others can support. How do stand up for myself, what helps me relax?



In art we will be making harvest prints, traditional tales collages, and focus on improving our observational drawing skills. We will use cross hatching, shading and different tones of pencil to create different effects

In DT we will be making finger puppets, bear masks and miniature houses. We will also make gingerbread characters focusing on weighing, measuring and combining ingredients
