# Whiskers, Paws and Claws

### **English**

Punctuation: We will be working on our punctuation including using question marks. Also we will look at using conjunctions such as and, but and so, to write compound sentences.

Reading: We will continue to investigate texts and build our confidence in answering questions around those texts.

# Science

In Science we will be learning about animals including humans. Exploring and comparing different habitats. Describing and identifying the basic needs of an animal for it's survival. Whilst looking at the life cycle of animals and how they obtain their food.

#### Maths
