

Through The Ages

In the 'Through the Ages' learning project, your child will learn about three different periods of British prehistory: the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will jump back in time to discover prehistoric settlements, monuments, burials and artefacts to uncover life through this period.

Maths - Place Value

Year 3: We will learn to:

- Recognise 3-digit numbers.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers.
- Read, write, compare and order numbers to 1,000.
- Count in multiples 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- Find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.

Year 4: We will learn to:

- Recognise numbers beyond 1,000.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers.
- Round numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000,
- Read roman numerals to 100. Find 1,000 more or less than a given number.
- Count backwards through 0 to include negative numbers.
- Count in multiples 6, 7, 9, 25 and 1000.

Geography and History - They will learn about stone age settlements and tools. We will learn about the Cheddar Man and the Beaker Folk.



D&T / Art - This half term the children will focus on D.T. learning about what is a healthy balanced diet = to design and make their own healthy meal using produce from the school garden.

R.E. - The children will look in detail at the question, 'What do Christians learn from the Creation Story?'. We will look at how the Creation story (Genesis 1) influences Christian lives and that of others.

Computing - The children will learn how computers connect to each other and what a network looks like.



French - Mrs Plummer will be teaching French, focusing on 'All About You.'

Music - Mr Odom will teach Year 3 structure and form. Year 4 will look at 20th Century Music. Both year groups will be using music technology.

Science - In Science, Mr Lawson will teach the children all about the body. They will learn about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals. They learn about the role of a skeleton and muscles and identify animals with different types of skeleton.

English

Writing - We'll write a portal story based on the book 'Stone Age Boy,' focusing on using dialogue. We will write a set of instructions based on 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth.'

Reading - Our novel study will be based on the book, 'Stig of the Dump.' We will focus skills to build reading with fluency this half term.

P.S.H.E. - Mrs Sarsons will be looking at how we can feel safe and how we can support ourselves through new situations.

P.E. - Make sure full P.E. kits are in school for Wednesday and Friday. Please provide appropriate clothing for the outdoors. This children will focus on Hockey, Football and Health and Fitness.
